William Timmerman, 64, has a long history with SCANA that began in 1978.

A native of Columbia, South Carolina, Timmerman earned a bachelor's degree in accounting from Duke University in 1968 and is a 1990 graduate of the Advanced Management Program at the Harvard Business School. He is an alumnus of Leadership South Carolina. His career includes four years of enlisted service in the United States Navy.

Timmerman was the senior vice president of finance and administration for Carolina Energies, Inc. when the company merged with South Carolina Electric & Gas Company in 1982 and later formed SCANA Corporation in 1984. He then assumed the role of vice president of finance and was later elected chief financial officer, followed by appointments to senior vice president and executive vice president. Elected to the board in 1991, Timmerman became president in 1995 and has been serving as the company's chairman, president and CEO since March 1997. Formerly a certified public accountant, Timmerman was previously employed with Arthur Andersen & Company, working with many southeast manufacturing companies and electric and natural gas utilities.

Timmerman serves on the board of directors of SCANA Corporation, Palmetto Business Forum, Fuqua School of Duke University, Nuclear Electric Insurance, Ltd., Palmetto Institute Board and Preholdings Inc. His past directorships include the Duke University Board of Visitors and Duke Neighborhood Partnership Board of Advisors, South Carolina Research Authority (chairman), Powertel, Inc., SouthernNet/Telecom USA, Wachovia Bank of South Carolina, Benedict College, South Carolina State Ports Authority and Palmetto Seed Corporation.
