Fant is active in his local community, currently serving on the board of directors of Palmetto Health Foundation, Columbia Urban League, Heathwood Hall Episcopal School and HOPE Worldwide of S.C. He serves as chairman of the board of trustees for Claflin University and is a past chairman of the board for the United Way of the Midlands.
