



SCANA Quick Facts

Headquartered in Columbia, South Carolina, SCANA is a \$9 billion, Fortune 500, energy-based holding company that has brought power and fuel to homes in the Carolinas and Georgia for 160 years. While SCANA does not generate or sell power or fuels, its subsidiaries do.

- SCANA began in 1846 when local business leaders met to form the Charleston Gas Light Company. Two years later, the company lit the streets of Charleston with gas streetlights.
- SCANA, the diversified holding company that it is today, was formed on December 31, 1984.
- SCANA is an energy-based holding company principally engaged, through subsidiaries, in regulated electric and natural gas utility operations and other non-regulated energy-related businesses in South Carolina, North Carolina and Georgia.
- SCANA serves approximately 620,000 electric customers in a service territory covering 25 counties throughout South Carolina.
- The company provides natural gas service to more than one million customers in a three state service area.
- SCANA has a workforce of more than 5,600 full and part-time employees.
