Jimmy Addison, 49, joined SCANA in 1991.

A native of Lancaster, South Carolina, Addison is a graduate of the University of South Carolina. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in accounting in 1982 and a Master of Accountancy degree the following year. He is also a certified public accountant in South Carolina.

Addison began his SCANA career as controller of SCE&G. In 1996, he assumed the additional responsibility of the information and technology group. He was appointed as vice president of finance for SCANA and its subsidiaries in 2001 and chief financial officer in 2006. As CFO, Addison is responsible for planning, directing and overseeing the organization's finance function including Accounting, Financial Planning, Corporate Taxes, Shareholder Services, Investor Relations, Rates and Regulatory Services, Risk Management, Treasury and New Nuclear Finance, along with oversight of Information Services and Technology.

Prior to joining SCANA, Addison spent seven years in public accounting with Deloitte and Touche's Charlotte and Columbia offices, and was also a partner in a Columbia CPA practice for approximately one year. In 2001, Addison received the Moore School of Business Distinguished Young Alumni award and is a 2006 graduate of The Liberty Fellowship.

Active in various community and non-profit organizations, Addison has previously served on committees for the Oliver Gospel Mission, the Saluda Shoals Foundation, Sexual Trauma Services and the USC Accounting Advisory Board. Currently, he serves as a director and Audit Committee member at South Carolina Bank & Trust, Treasurer of the Southeastern Electric Exchange, is director of the USC Moore School of Business Partnership Foundation (Audit Committee chair), director of the South Carolina Higher Education Foundation and is a member of the South Carolina Tax Realignment Commission.
