**Note:** SCE&G's earnings are adjusted in determining the GAAP-Adjusted Weather-Normalized EPS measurement to exclude the impact of abnormal weather in its electric business, the impact of tax reform, and the impairment loss associated with the VC Summer nuclear construction project. Earnings from SCE&G's gas business and PSNC Energy are not adjusted for weather in determining GAAP-Adjusted Weather-Normalized EPS as those businesses have regulatory mechanisms in place designed to weather normalize margins. SCANA Energy's earnings are not adjusted in determining the GAAP-Adjusted Weather-Normalized EPS measurement as the impact of abnormal weather is generally insignificant on an annual basis.
